He/she will keep close contact to the manufacturer to receive information and forward these to his/her instructors, the Chief Pilot AW139 and the Person Documents & Standards in order to keep a high standardization level amongst all pilots. He/she will also analyze checks and training sessions as well as instructor/examiner feedback, use this feedback for future training & checking developments and plan (together with the Chief Pilot/Person Documents & Standards) standardization meetings if necessary.

He/she will continuously maintain OM Part D in regard to AW139 issues.

He/she keeps him/her-self informed about type related information, occurrences, incidents and accidents in order to update training sessions.

He/she will work with NPCT and Chief Instructor H145 on OPC programs in respect to OPC session and will plan OCC and OPC sessions.
